Both films center around the same group of young teenagers that has won national essay contests writing mystery stories. In their latest project, however, they find, that they have been assembled surreptitiously to actually solve the mystery of a lost treasure, and they find themselves embroiled with real life-threatening danger. But by working together they unify and overcome great obstacles to prevail.

As a departure from feature film we are excited to announce a new television series entitled "Staged". "Staged" centers around life in a small town and the drama behind the scenes of a small town theater. Finally rounding out our slate is the compelling action adventure film entitled "Desert Prey". This film brings attention to the heinous widespread crime of human organ trafficking. At about the same time, the city fathers in his hometown in Texas decided to revive the community theater that had languished for years ... and they thought of Brooks.


So the frustrated actor now returns home to the job and the task of jerking a small town community theater into shape.

This story has it all, with the ocean, pirates, sharks, mystery and adventure as our protagonist, Billy McAlester, an awarded high school mystery writer raised by the sea, is contacted by a shady businessman named Maurice LaFavre. The smooth LaFavre has heard that Billy won the national creative writing contest with an entry about finding a fabulous buried treasure, and now asks him to assist in finding another fabled "trove" that was purportedly left on the nearby Island of Cumberland many years ago.

It seems this "treasure" has to do with a case of "spirits", amazingly the only one distilled by a company that had been created by some very famous and distinguished gentlemen back in the early 20th century, including heavyweight champion Gene Tunney, steel magnate Andrew Carnegie, and novelist Ernest Hemingway!!!

LaFavre contends that he is strictly interested in this "find" for the purpose of historical value ... a claim that will be quickly proven false! Billy collects his old, competitive writing team to help navigate the plots and subplots of what turns out to be an adventure far beyond what any of the team bargained for. As these plots thicken, Billy and his team realize that Maurice and his men may not be without personal motives in their thirst to find this hidden treasure, and that indeed the closer his team comes to solving the mystery, the closer they may be to sealing their own doom!!!

Billy's academic prowess as well as his pugilistic skills serve the team well as with wit, skill, brawn and brain they solve the mystery and actually find the cache of "spirits" now known as the SPIRITS OF CUMBERLAND!!!



Billy is a handsome, sixteen year old, middleweight Golden Gloves Champion. Cindy is a pretty teen from India, always ready for adventure John is a nerdy, African-American honor roll student from Boston. Lauren is a teenage, Beverly Hills diva, always fussing with makeup and appearance. Howard is a small, timid Mexican-American student. Together, this eclectic group of teenagers is about to embark on a wild adventure.

The five are brought together at a "desert retreat" in Mason, Texas as a prize for winning the top spots in the national creative writing competition. While Lauren is presenting some cell phone pics from a desert excursion with the rest of the kids, Cindy notices some strange markings at the base of a large rock structure. The others dismiss these as just random creases caused by the years, but she insists that by adding a line and a squiggle in a couple of places, a cryptic message is conveyed in her own Hindi language.


The message: 7-STONE...C-TRAIN...GOLD.
